The well project is about to be complete. As you can see, they have water. They are building a cistern to store water from the well, so water can be easily distributed. Due to all the unrest, they could not travel to Port au Prince to purchase a Solar panel system. So the church ended up buying a generator and an electrical water pump. Water from this

well is used for the church, school, irrigation for crops as well as other areas in the community.

Evangelism/Discipleship: Jacmel

Pastor Belizaire (CFEEBO) and Pastor Cloveus (Christ Pour Tous) continue to preach the gospel in this mountainous region. In March, each church led separate outreach campaigns and the Lord blessed! Silo School/church: Cite Soleil





Silo school has been open since the middle of March. The area is safe, but a few students still do not attend classes. They feed the children and staff 3 days a week. Silo church is also open. Pastor Emmanuel continues to shepherd the congregation there.

AFCA School/Church: Delmas





The AFCA School worked online during the month of March. After Easter, they came back in person. The children and staff are fed three days a week. For safety, they wear ordinary clothes (no uniforms). This is a particular blessing for AFCA because many other schools in the area are not open due to security issues.

AFCA church had a great celebration of Easter. During that week we had a spiritual conference about the meaning of Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross. On Good Friday in the afternoon, they had their traditional service called "Commemoration of Jesus-Christ Death on the Cross", and on Sunday Easter we commemorated the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.
